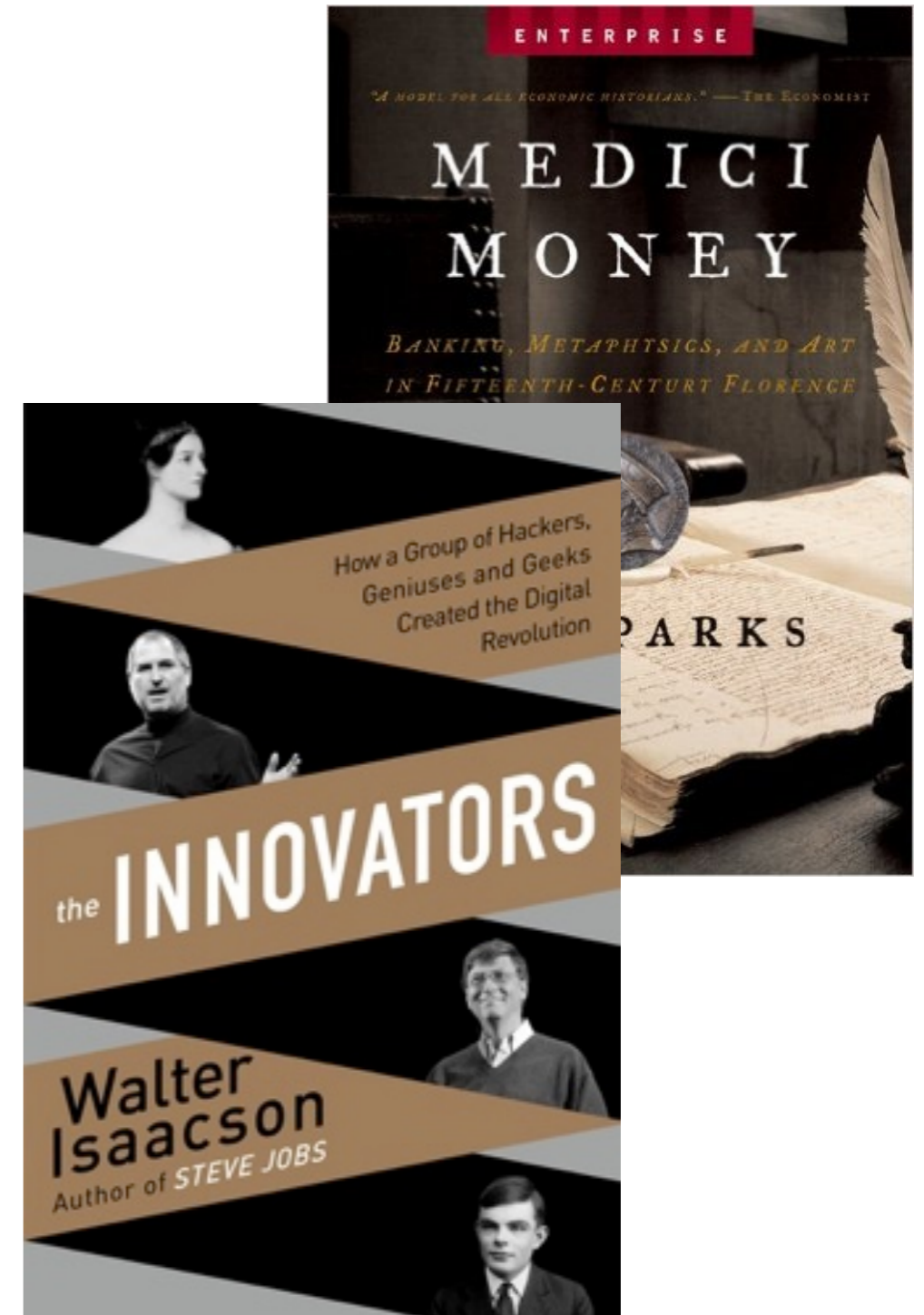

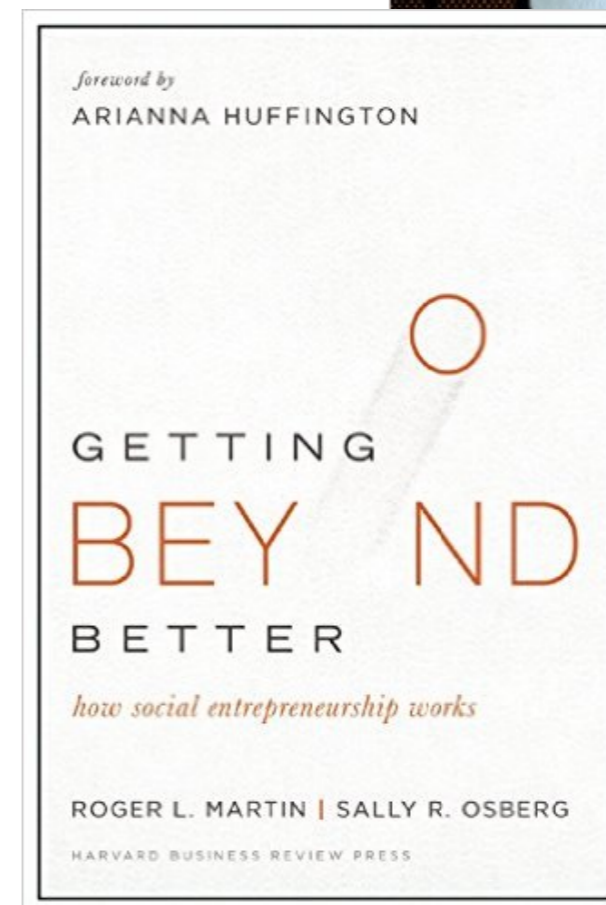
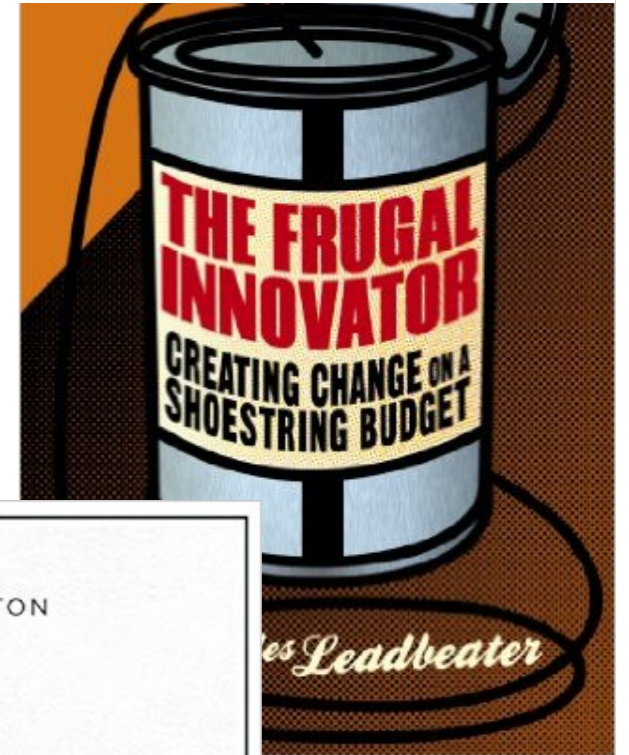
History of Entrepreneurship

- What has history taught us about these questions?



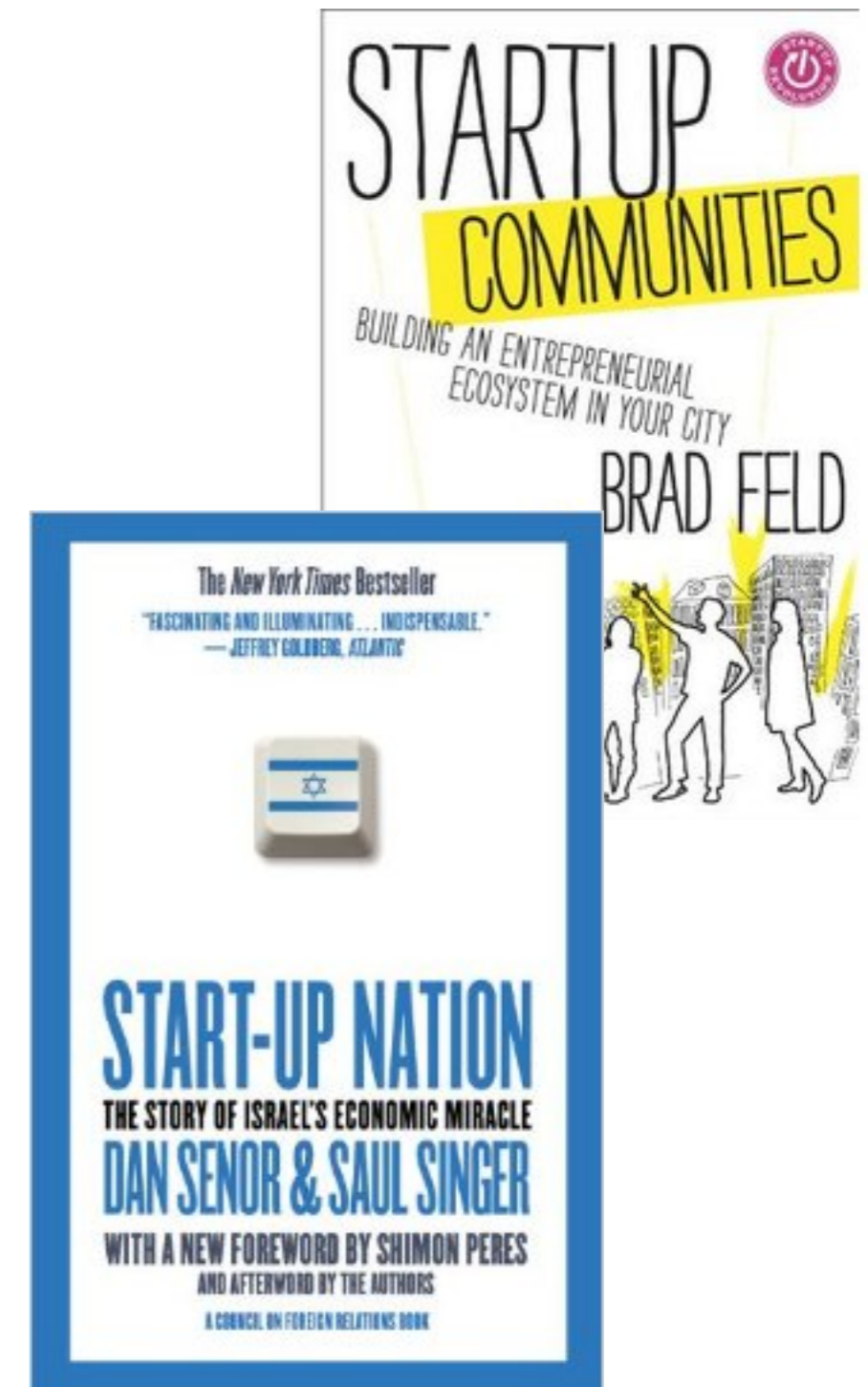
Social Entrepreneurship
